Patient Story



Gul Sher

Gul Sher a young man of 20 years age comes from a remote village in District Khairpur (Sindh). His father died about 3 years ago. He lives with his mother, two brothers and a sister – all younger to him. Being the eldest son, he is responsible to feed the family.

*Gul Sher used to sell seasonal fruits on a wheel barrow and earn about **Rs. 4,000/-** per month. This meager amount was hardly sufficient to make both ends meet. His two brothers and sister were studying in the village school.*

*Some time back, Gul Sher started losing vision in both eyes. Since he was unable to afford treatment, he ultimately became blind in both eyes. As a result he was unable to sell fruits and the entire family was in a dire financial crisis. The education and the future of the young children was also at serious risk .Then the miracle happened. Some body told the family about LRBT's Free Secondary Eye Hospital at Gambat which is close to Khairpur and that all treatment was provided **absolutely free of cost.***

Gul Sher was brought by his mother to the LRBT Free Secondary Eye Hospital at Gambat. Bilateral cataract was diagnosed. Gul Sher was successively operated in both eyes. His sight has been restored and he is back to work.

The family is thankful to LRBT for saving them from starvation.

HOSPITAL AT MANSEHRA

The Earthquake Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Authority (ERRA) approved the structural designs of the LRBT Free Secondary Eye Hospital on Balakot Road, about 13 Kilometer from Mansehra.

Contract was awarded and the construction started on 10th August 2007. The contractor has committed to complete construction in 15 months. The hospital is thus expected to be functional in the last quarter of 2008. This hospital will replace the existing temporary hospital which was established in rented premises immediately after the earthquake in October 2005, which will then be closed.

HOSPITAL AT ARIFWALA

Contract for the hospital at Arifwala was awarded and the construction started on 7th July 2007. The contractor has committed to complete construction in 12 months. This Free Secondary Eye Hospital at Arifwala is expected to be functional by the third quarter of 2008.

HOSPITAL AT PASRUR

Construction work at LRBT's Free Secondary Eye Hospital at Pasrur which commenced in October 2006 is progressing satisfactorily. The hospital is expected to be fully operational by January 2008. Recruitment of doctors, paramedics and support staff is in progress. An application has been submitted to Pakistan Bait-ul-Mal for a grant of **Rs. 5 Million** to purchase some of the equipment.

EXPANSION OF KHANEWAL HOSPITAL

The Khanewal hospital is planned to be expanded. The expansion includes: a larger waiting shed, two screening rooms, larger operation theatre to house 4 operation tables, sterilization room, male and female wards. The expansion will be divided into 2 phases. After the expansion this hospital will be converted from a mini to Free Secondary Eye

Hospital. The first phase of the expansion is being funded by Shell and Dr. Fawad Zafar.

EXPANSION AT TANDO BAGO

An anonymous donor has committed to provide funds for the expansion of the Tando Bago hospital. The expansion will include larger operation theatre, wards, waiting shed with additional rooms for screening and refraction, a patients canteen and additional residential accommodation for doctors.

Following doctors have been trained in Small Incision Cataract Surgery (SICS) under the "*Seeing is believing*" programme funded by Standard Chartered Bank through Sight Savers International (SSI):

So far 9008 Small Incision Cataract Surgeries (SICS) have been performed under this programme.

FREE EYE SCREENING CAMPS

TOBA TEK SINGH :

An LRBT team from Lar hospital carried out a free eye screening camp at Toba Tek Singh on 11th August 2007.

A total 511 patients were screened. Out of which 300 were medicated, 170 refracted and 138 referred for surgery / detailed examination.

Our LRBT team carried out a Free Eye Screening Camp at Dharki. A total of 450 patients were screened. Out of which 282 were medicated and 110 referred to our Gambat Hospital for detailed examination / surgery.

A total of 275 patients were screened. Out of which 144 were medicated and 24 referred to our Multan Hospital for detailed examination / surgery.

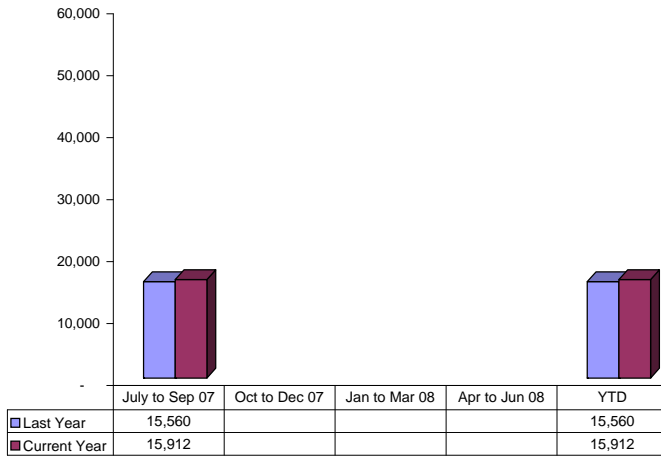

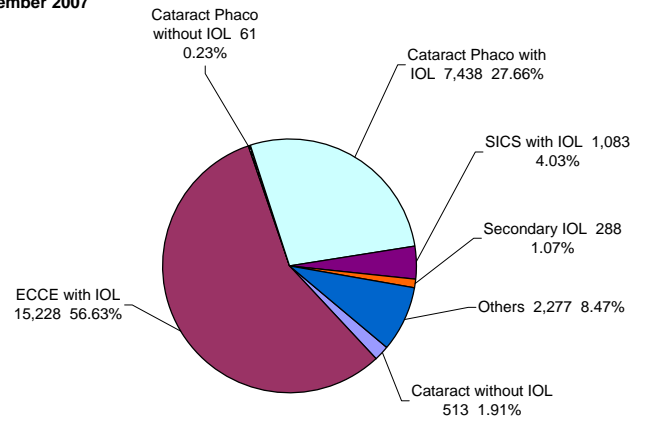
