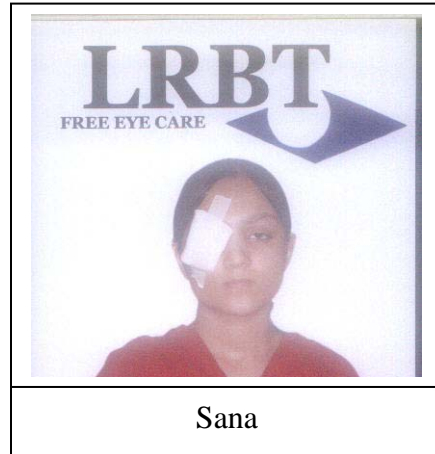


Our 13 Millionth Patient



Pakistan, a third world developing country, lacks necessary resource of providing its people with medical and health facilities and it is the underprivileged and the destitute that suffer the most. HOSPITAL AT PASRUR

The construction work of Pasrur Hospital is progressing satisfactorily. The hospital is expected to be ready by end 2007.

HOSPITAL AT ARIFWALA

The contract for the construction of Arifwala Hospital has been awarded. The contractor is expected to start

the work by 21st July 2007 and the construction is scheduled to be completed in 12 months i.e., July 2008.

HOSPITAL AT MANSEHRA

The approval by ERRA (Earthquake Re-Construction and Re-habilitation Authority) is expected shortly. The construction work should start by end of July 2007. The hospital is scheduled to be operational by October 2008.

RE-MODELLING AND RENOVATION OF QUETTA HOSPITAL

The Quetta Hospital has been remodelled which has resulted in creating rooms for Biometry, Admission, Dispensary, Store, Larger Buffer Zone out side OT, Larger Equipment room to house B scan, Yag Laser. Field Analyzer and Photocoagulator. Separate Registration Counters for Male & Female patients have also been created.

PRIMARY EYE CARE CENTRE

A Primary Eye Care Centre has been established at Kot Momin in District Sargodha. The clinic is functioning on daily basis.

FREE EYE SCREENING CAMPS

Quetta

An LRBT team carried out a Free Eye Screening Camp at Gardgiap (Mastung) on 22nd April 2007. A total of 356 patients were screened out of which 207 were medicated / refracted and 85 referred to Quetta Hospital for detailed examination and / or surgery.

Lar (Multan)

An LRBT team carried out a Free Eye Screening Camp at Toba Tek Sing. A total of 500 patients were

screened. Out which 350 were medicated / refracted and 100 were referred to Lar Hospital for detailed examination and / or surgery.

Mandra (Rawalpindi)

In collaboration with Shell Pakistan, an LRBT team carried out a Free Eye Screening Camp at the Shell Pakistan Chaklala Depot (Rawalpindi) on 5th June 2007.

A total of 175 patients were screened out which 167 were medicated / refracted and 8 referred to our Mandra Hospital for detailed examination and / or surgery.

RE-MODELLING OF KORANGI HOSPITAL

After completion of 2nd floor the ground and 1st floors have re-modeled to house 94 beds and the following subspecialties.

- a. VITREO RETINA AND LASER.
- b. MEDICAL RETINA & LASER.
- c. CORNEA & EXTERNAL EYE DISORDERS.
- d. GLAUCOMA.
- e. OCULOPLASTIC.
- f. GENERAL OPHTHALMOLOGY.

The Paediatric Clinic has been established in the newly built 2nd floor.

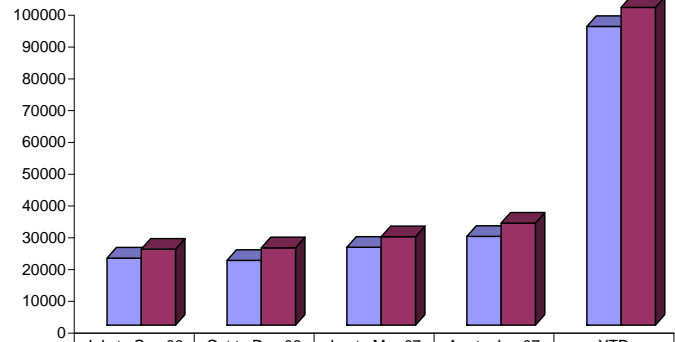

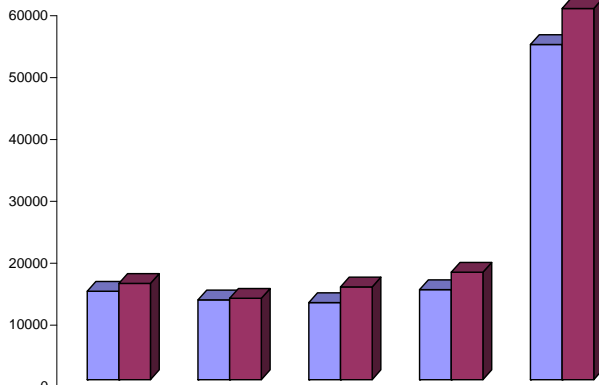

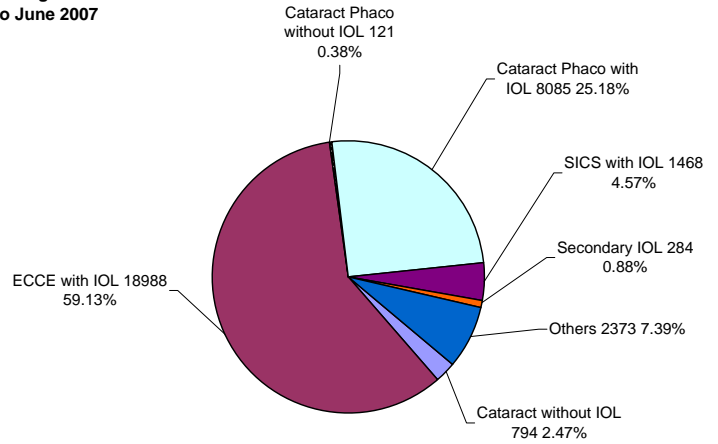
